Parish Pastoral Council Open Meeting - Thank you to those who attended our Parish Council Open Meeting on Tuesday 19th.

From my perspective, it was very noticeable that the ethnic communities who make up our Parish are not represented in our parish leadership. We need to work on that together.

It was a constructive and informative gathering. We are working out how to get the minutes on our website. In light of Cardinal Pell's sentence, we reflected on how we as Church are feeling at present. Common themes to immerge were: "hurt, confusion and anger", "this is a seminal time in our Church", and "we must be united and supportive of each other".

Discussions on Parish initiatives involved: a maintenance schedule (painting of exterior of church), the grassed area known by some as "the paddock" and used by some as a carpark (this will come under review), possible relocation of choir and musicians to the rear of the church near the Sacristy, Work Health & Safety and Professional Standard training and to update our Parish Pastoral Plan.

It became evident that we need more volunteers to support all the Ministries in our parish.
